The VII Meeting of Peruvian Scientists in Europe -SINAPSIS 2023- will be held in presential mode from July 13th to 15th in the multicultural city of Geneva in Switzerland. The venue for the first two days of Sinapsis-2023 will be the Room V of the <u>Palais des Nations de la ONU</u>. On Saturday, prizes to best presented works as well as the closing ceremony will take place at the Peruvian Consulate in Geneva.

SINAPSIS is an annual space for scientific discussion organized by a team of Peruvian scientists since 2016. This event seeks to facilitate cooperation between researchers and strengthen ties with Peru. Previous versions of Sinapsis gathered in each edition an average of 80 Peruvian and foreign scientists who have been developing research in various fields of knowledge such as biology, chemistry, medicine, physics, mathematics, engineering, among others. Moreover, in recent editions of the event, various areas have also been included, such as social sciences, women in science, science in Quechua, science outreach, and business entrepreneurship.

In this edition we are working on organizing plenary sessions given by prominent Peruvian and foreign researchers from renowned European universities and research centers. This year we will have the illustrious participation of Professor <u>Hugo Duminil-Copin</u>, who is the most recent winner (2022) of the <u>Fields Medal</u> (equivalent to the *Nobel Prize* in mathematics) for his "outstanding contributions to the theory of probabilistic transitions of phase in statistical physics".

We will feature a series of oral and poster presentations on a wide range of scientific disciplines. In addition, we will have round tables where topics of interest to our country will be addressed, such as scientific cooperation, networking, and promotion of technology and innovation in Peru. We will also have a talk by the current director of CONCYTEC. All this will be complemented with activities such as a technical visit and a camaraderie dinner.

Being aware of the fundamental role of science and technology in the development of our country, we hope that both, researchers, and the general public, will join us in this event. SINAPSIS is <u>completely free</u> for all participants thanks to the Department of Science and Technology Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Peru.
